Parade Rules & Agreement

Distribution of candy, literature, branded items, etc:

- Only individuals walking along the curb are permitted to distribute candy, literature, or other items to spectators.
- Throwing/tossing items into the crowd is strictly prohibited. All items must be handed to spectators.
- It is recommended that a minimum of four people walk with their entry to distribute candy, literature, or other items.
- · It is required that each individual not riding in/on a vehicle keeps up with their entry at all times
- All printed material must be handed to spectators respectfully, not forced.

Horses or Horse-Drawn Units:

- All entries involving animals must have a plan in place to clean up any waste immediately.
- Units without proper cleanup arrangements may be denied participation.
- The parade committee will not provide waste removal services.

Pets

- Pets are not allowed without advance written approval from the parade committee.
- Requests must be submitted in writing before the registration deadline.
- Approved animal entries must include cleanup provisions and must remain leashed.
- Failure to meet these conditions may result in removal from the parade.

Unit Breakdowns

- Any unit that breaks down must move out of the lineup.
- · If repairs can be made safely, reentry is allowed only with permission from parade officials.

Float & Vehicle Safety

- All entries with floats and/or walking must have a designated individual to monitor safety. You are responsible to ensure the safety of all participants in your entry.
- Jumping or exiting a moving vehicle during the Parade is strictly prohibited.
- Limbs must remain inside float/vehicle at all times
- · Failure to comply or any behavior that threatens the safety of participants is cause for removal from the parade lineup

Keep Your Entry Moving

- All entries must keep pace with the rest of the parade
- Stopping your vehicle during the parade without instruction from a parade official or public safety officer is strictly prohibited.

Youth Entries

- Youth participants should ride in a vehicle when possible.
- · Large walking groups must have a pace vehicle and stay in line with it.

Emergency Vehicles

• In the event of an emergency, all entries must pull to the right side of the street and remain there until the parade resumes or directed to move.

All entries will receive an Entry ID, which must be clearly displayed at the front of the entry. (i.e., entries with a float should place their entry ID in the front window of the vehicle)

By submitting this application, I confirm that I have read and agree to follow all parade rules. I understand that violations may result in removal from this and future Arts in the Alley Community Parades. I acknowledge that participation is at my own risk, that I carry liability insurance, and further assume all liability for participation and all participants in my entry. The City of Grove City, The Grove City Area Chamber of Commerce, The Grove City Girls' Club, and any sponsors of the parade will be held harmless. I understand that The Grove City Area Chamber of Commerce and the Parade Committee may adjust rules and policies at their discretion and all decisions are final.
